Dogs are welcome but MUST be kept on a short lead and under control at all times. Any Junior or Cub shooting at a Wight Company event MUST be accompanied by a parent or adult shoot guardian at all times. The parent / guardian will be responsible for the conduct and safety of the junior / cub. Please remember archery can be a dangerous sport if due care is not taken. Our open shoots take place in woodland, over uneven and sometimes muddy ground. Participants take part at their own risk and have a duty of care for their own safety and property and that of others. The club and landowners offers no provision for safe storage and visitors to the shoot must make sure they keep their possessions with them, or safely secured at all times. To the full extent permitted by law the Wight Company, its officers and agents exclude all liability for any personal injury (except in that caused by the negligence of any of the above in connection with the organisation and operation of the competition), and any loss, direct or indirect, expense, costs, damage however caused, including by reason of any negligence on the part of any of the above. If for any reason a person's conduct appears to the shoot organiser or any responsible agent of the Wight Company to be inappropriate, the club Reserves the right to refuse entry or to remove from its shoots any person without giving reason for doing so.
